



## SUGGESTED CLOTHING AND PREPARATION LIST FOR A TWO-WEEK PROGRAM

This list indicates the kind and quantity of items the average camper needs during a two-week stay at Camp Yofi. It is meant as a guide, and it is not necessary that a camper have each item in the quantity suggested.

Also, it is very important that you have **NAME TAGS ON OR CLEARLY LABEL EACH GARMENT.**

### SLEEPING GEAR

- 1 Heavy Camp Blanket
- 1 Pillow
- 4 Twin size sheets (2 flat, 2 fitted)
- 2 Pillow Cases
- 1 Twin Mattress Pad – A MUST!

### CLOTHING

- 3 Bathing suits or swim trunks
- 12 Pair of socks
- 4 Pajamas (2 light, 2 heavy)
- 4 Pairs of jeans or long pants
- 12 Sets of underwear
- 5 Pairs of shorts
- 1 Rain Poncho with hood
- 1 Bathrobe
- 1 Lightweight jacket
- 8 T-shirts
- 2 White polo or oxford shirts for Shabbat
- 2 Warm sweatshirts
- 3 Long-sleeved shirts
- 1-2 Hats

### TOILETRIES

- Soap, toothpaste, shampoo
- Soap dish
- Comb and brush
- Toothbrush and holder
- Sunscreen
- Deodorant

### TOWELS

- 2 Large Beach Towels
- 2 Shower Towels
- 2 Washcloths or Package of Disposable Washcloths

### SHOES

- 1 Pair of Hiking shoes
- 1 Pair of Sneakers
- 1 Pair of shower shoes (thongs)

### MANDATORY MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Insect Repellant
- Water bottle (one quart is the best size)
- Flashlight with extra bulbs & batteries
- Laundry bag (labeled with camper's name)
- Ballpoint pen
- Pre-addressed postcards
- Writing paper, envelopes, and stamps
- Chapstick

- Rubber sheet for bed wetters
- Sunglasses
- Musical instrument
- Reading material/quiet games
- Posters/decorations for cabin
- Camera and film (optional)
- Softball glove



## SUGGESTED CLOTHING AND PREPARATION LIST MORE INFORMATION

### BAGGAGE

Each camper may bring two duffel bags, one for clothing and one for sleeping gear. Each duffel bag should be tagged with two sturdy name tags with your child's name and address.

### CLOTHING

**AGAIN, NAME TAGS ON ALL ITEMS ARE A MUST.**

**It is customary for campers to wear a white shirt for Friday night dinner and services.**

### LAUNDRY

Laundry service is provided once each session for 2-week campers, twice for 3-week campers, and three times for 4-week campers. It is not recommended for delicate clothing, expensive clothing, or clothing that has never been washed. **Camp is not responsible for clothing that is lost or damaged in the laundry.** We find that younger children tend to run out of clothing a little faster, and you may want to take this into account when packing.

### CANTEEN, TRIPS, & SPENDING MONEY

Campers will have the opportunity of buying snacks and logo items from the canteen each day. No additional spending money is needed or recommended. Expenditures are not itemized and unused money is not refunded.

### ITEMS TO LEAVE HOME

**You may be sent home without a refund if you bring:** fireworks, drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, matches, weapons, or other dangerous instruments. **The following will be confiscated if you bring them:** cell phones, large fans, TVs, VCRs, stereos, appliances for heating food, camping knives, tapes or CDs with violent, sexual, or profane lyrics, and food of any kind. Food that is confiscated will not be returned. **It is recommended you not bring:** makeup, hair dryers, jewelry, expensive clothing, or iPods or other expensive electronic games/equipment.
