### Transportation

We are proud to offer programming to our neighborhood schools. Transportation from the following schools is available at an additional cost, Newport Coast, Andersen and Bonita Canyon. We require a minimum of five children for the bus to pick up at the schools. Club J staff members will walk to Vista Verde and Tarbut V'Torah to pick up the students.

**NEW:** We are NOW picking up from Vista Verde every-day at 1:30 and at 3 p.m. For families who have children in the middle kindergarten we will meet the children at their classroom and walk them down to the JCC. They will join the other kindergarten children from neighboring schools for snack and an afternoon of fun.

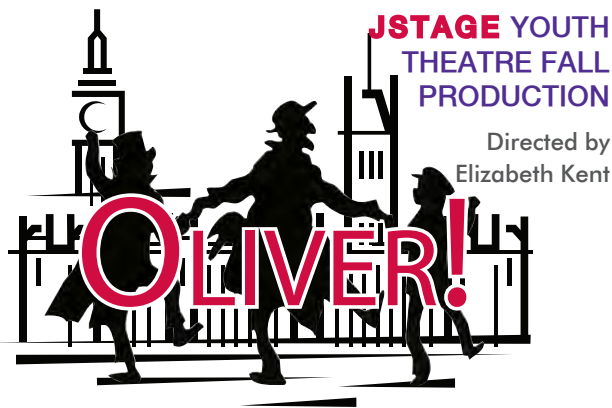

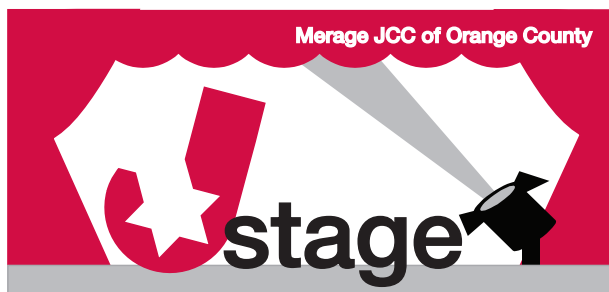
